



Government Decision 1012/2020 (I. 31.) on Setting Up the Coronavirus Operational Group

1. The Government reviewed the situation regarding the coronavirus epidemic that originated in the territory of the People's Republic of China and concluded that in order to protect the citizens of Hungary, it is essential to closely monitor developments in the health and epidemiological situation, to organise the necessary measures effectively and, to that end, coordinate the relevant activities of public entities.

2. To carry out the activity specified in point 1, the Government shall establish a Coronavirus Operational Group (hereinafter referred to as "Operational Group").

3. The Operational Group shall be directed by the Minister of the Interior in cooperation with the Minister of Human Capacities.

4. Members of the Operational Group are:

- a)* Minister of the Interior;
- b)* Minister of Human Capacities;
- c)* director-general for public security of the Ministry of the Interior;
- d)* Chief commissioner of the Police;
- e)* director-general of State Health and Medical Services Centre;
- f)* director-general of South-Pest Hospital Centre – National Institute of Haematology and Infectology;
- g)* director-general of National Directorate General for Immigration;
- h)* director-general of National Directorate General for Disaster Management;
- i)* director-general of Hungarian National Ambulance and Emergency Service;
- j)* chief medical officer;
- k)* director-general of Counter Terrorism Centre for Information and Criminal Analysis.

5. Meetings of the Operational Group shall also be attended by persons requested by the Minister of the Interior.
