



Government Decree 40/2020 (III. 11.) on the Declaration of State of Danger

The Government,
acting within its competence conferred under Article 53(1) of the Fundamental Law,
acting within its original legislative power conferred under Article 53(2) of the Fundamental Law having regard to Sections 2 and 3,
acting within its competence conferred under Article 15(1) of the Fundamental Law, has adopted the following Decree:

1. Declaration of state of danger

Section 1 The Government declares a state of danger covering the whole territory of Hungary in order to mitigate the consequences of the human epidemic endangering the safety of life and property, for the protection of health and life of Hungarian citizens.

Section 2 (1) The Government delegates the Prime Minister as the Government member in charge of emergency response measures during the state of danger.

(2) The Prime Minister shall be assisted in carrying out his duties under Subsection (1) by the Coronavirus Operational Group.

Section 3 (1) Emergency measures related to the state of danger shall be introduced in specific other government decrees.

(2) The Government shall review the need for maintaining the state of danger on a regular basis.

(3) The Government asks all citizens to cooperate in the implementation of measures relevant to the special legal order.

2. Closing provisions

Section 4 This Decree shall enter into force at 15:00 hours on the day of its promulgation.
